

PRINT SALON

1. **SALON DATE:** December 16, 2008 at 8:00 p.m.
2. **ENTRIES:** Maximum of FIVE entries per member.
3. **SPECIFICATIONS:** Prints must be mounted or securely fastened to a backing board for protection. Over-matts are permitted.

Outside dimensions including matt, must be no larger than 16 X 20". If you are planning to enter prints into the GTCCC competition, you choose one of the following sizes: Large Prints must be mounted on a mounting board measuring 16" x 20". Small Prints must be mounted on a mounting board measuring 8.5" x 12". (Print size can be any size within these 2 dimensions.)

Due to hanging and storing challenges, we can't accept framed prints or prints with glass or mounts with hangers, wire or cord attached.

More than one image on a matt will be counted as one entry.

The entrant must have taken the original photograph from which the print is made. Prints may be produced by either traditional chemical darkroom or computer printer techniques OR be commercially produced at a lab.

No identification is to be visible on the front of the image or matt.

On the back, in the top right hand corner, print your Name and Title of the image. Also put an arrow pointing to the top indicating which way the image should be viewed.

Prints must be submitted to the Salon at the meeting on November 25, 2008.

Entries must be accompanied by a completed entry form, which will be made available at club meetings as soon as possible. Entry form must indicate the entrant's name and print titles.

Prints are to be taken home by the maker at the end of the Salon exhibition on December 16.

4. **REFRESHMENTS:** We will be asking a number of members to volunteer to bring a special plate or dish of finger food items, either sweet or savoury. Both will be needed. The Hospitality committee will take care of serving the refreshments, to include cider, juice, tea and coffee. Naturally, Christmas will be a bit of a theme.
5. **GUESTS:** Everyone is welcome! The idea is to showcase our significant talent to as many people as possible, so bring your friends and family!
6. **NOTE:** The committee is going to work hard to make this a special and classy showcase event, and with the members' help, wants to make it a memorable evening through the enjoyment of a fabulous exhibition *and* fabulous refreshments! In addition, attendees will be asked to vote for prints to receive various awards, including best in show.
