### **COMPETITION ENTRY RULES**

2007 – 2008

- 1. Maximum of 3 entries per member.**
- 2. All entries must be identified with the maker's name and title.**  
Please follow the Guidelines for Transparencies, Digital and Print entries in the Handbook.
- 3. All entries are to be submitted to the Clinic Captains by October 23, 2007.**  
No late entries will be accepted. Entries are to be accompanied by a LIST, titled WILDFLOWER ENTRY, and showing maker's name and the title of each image.
- 4. Images entered into any Clinics prior to the 2006 -7 Club year are not eligible.**  
They may be entered into Clinics 1, 3, 4 and 5, in the 2007-2008 year.  
This will make them eligible to be entered into the Year-End Awards.
- 5. Image entries must fit the definition as printed in the Handbook.**

*Any wild Canadian plant that is in flower, including grasses, sedges, shrubs and trees, i.e. Angiosperm. The image may include other parts of the plant but the flower/s should be present and the plant identifiable. The award is not for other parts of the plant without the flower/s, nor for algae, fungi, mosses, ferns or evergreens. Flowers found in a Field Guide to Wildflowers or Trees and Shrubs may be used as reference.*

**Images must be titled with the common name.**

**In order to retain authenticity of the subject no manipulation of the image is permissible.**

The following post-capture processing procedures will be acceptable:

- 1. Colour balance and colour saturation.*
- 2. Removal of scratches and dust marks.*
- 3. Adjustment of exposure and contrast, including dodging and burning - techniques commonly used in traditional printmaking.*
- 4. Sharpening*
