YEAR-END AWARDS

1. Members may submit up to ten images that have been entered in Clinics during the current season, with a minimum score of 19 points, using the Year-End Entry form.
2. Judges for the Year-End Awards shall not be members of the Trillium Photographic Club. They shall be selected by the Clinic Chairperson, subject to the approval of the Executive.
3. Eligible images entered for Awards shall be judged in their original Medium and Category.

YEAR-END AWARDS will be given to 1st, 2nd, & 3rd Place and an additional 10% of entries will receive Honourable Mentions in each Medium – (Slides and Prints) and in each Category (Pictorial, Nature & Creative).

Slide of the Year – Chosen from the winners of Pictorial, Nature & Creative entries.

Print of the Year – Chosen from the winners of Pictorial, Nature & Creative entries.

Image of the Year – Chosen from the Winners of the Slide of the Year and Print of the Year.

CLUB AWARDS

Club Awards are given annually using the scores obtained at the Clinics during the current season.

- All images must have a score of 20 and over to be eligible for Club Awards.

Single Medium Awards will be awarded to the member obtaining the highest total for 9 Prints and the member obtaining the highest total for 9 Slides during the Clinics in the current season. A minimum score of 20 must be obtained for an image to be eligible.

Merit Awards to Bronze, Silver, Gold and Masters members for 4 Pictorial, 4 Nature and 4 Creative images that have the highest total score during the current season. The images can be from Slides or Prints.

Louise Elder Trophy for Best Wildflower is awarded to the member with the top image entered into this annual competition. This award is for any wild Canadian plant that is in flower including grasses, sedges, shrubs and trees, i.e any Angiosperm. The image may include other parts of the plant but the flower/s should be present and the plant identifiable. The award is not for other parts of the plant without the flower/s, nor for fungi, mosses, ferns or evergreens. Flowers found in a Field Guide to Wildflowers or Trees and Shrubs may be used as reference. Images must be titled with proper common name. No manipulation of an image beyond that outlined in the rules is permitted.

PROFICIENCY AWARDS

Proficiency Awards will be awarded to Masters, Gold, Silver and Bronze members that have the highest total score for 12 images during the current season. All images must have a score of 21 or over.
